The WBO contributes with supplies to Argentine children

The World Boxing Organization held the WBO Kids Drugs Free campaign in Argentina for the fifth consecutive year. At the Boxing Federation of Argentina (FAB) Stadium, and together with that institution, backpacks and school supplies were distributed among 100 children from the *Fundación Temas*, from the Villa 21/24 de Barracas, in the Federal Capital. Another 70 kids received backpacks and sportswear for boxing at the *Temas* gymnasium.

On the afternoon of Saturday April 24, the WBO –represented by its **President, Francisco Valcárcel**, Esq., and the Latino Region President for the WBO, **Jorge Eugenio Molina**—also contributed with supplies (such as bags, gloves, mitts, hand wraps, knuckle and fist guards and ropes), to two additional NGO’s: *Revivir*, an organization that also works against drug addiction from its headquarters in the city of Avellaneda of Greater Buenos Aires, and *SER* (Social, Entrepreneurship Responsibility), from the *Tigre* team.
