



RESOLUTION OF THE WBO EXECUTIVE BOARD

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2010 Sergio Martinez was awarded this WBO 160 lb Championship; and

WHEREAS, Section 15(c) of the WBO World Championships Rules provides:

“SECTION 15. NONCHAMPIONSHIP FIGHTS or NON-WBO CHAMPIONSHIP FIGHTS

(c) A WBO Champion who wins a non-WBO Championship in weight class that is different than the weight class in which he holds his WBO Championship must decide within ten (10) days of the non-WBO Championship which title in which weight class he will retain. No WBO Champion may hold a non-WBO Championship in a weight class that is different from the weight class of his WBO Championship.”

WHEREAS additional notice was given to Sergio Martinez of the provisions of WBO Rule 15(c) on May 24, 2010; and

WHEREAS, The Executive Board of the WBO, having received the recommendation of the World Championship Committee this date that Sergio Martinez has not elected to vacate his 154lb WBC Championship\

NOW THEREFORE ITSIS RESOLVED that the WBO Middleweight Champion of Sergio Martinez is hereby because Sergio Martinez has not elected to vacated his WBC Super Welterweight Championship as per WBO Rule 15(c).

Sergio Martinez is hereby notified that you may appeal this determination within ten (10) days of this date only per Rule 34, which provides:

“Any WBO Participant, including, but not limited to a Boxer, Manager,

or Promoter or affected by a determination of the World Championship Committee who wishes to contest such a determination must, as his sole and exclusive remedy, file a Complaint pursuant to the WBO Appeal Regulations. In all cases the complaint shall be referred to the WBO President, who may attempt for a reasonable period to resolve the complaint amicably. The WBO President may reject a complaint or he may refer it to the Complaints and Grievance Committee which shall determine the complaint or grievance in accordance with the WBO Appeals Regulations."
